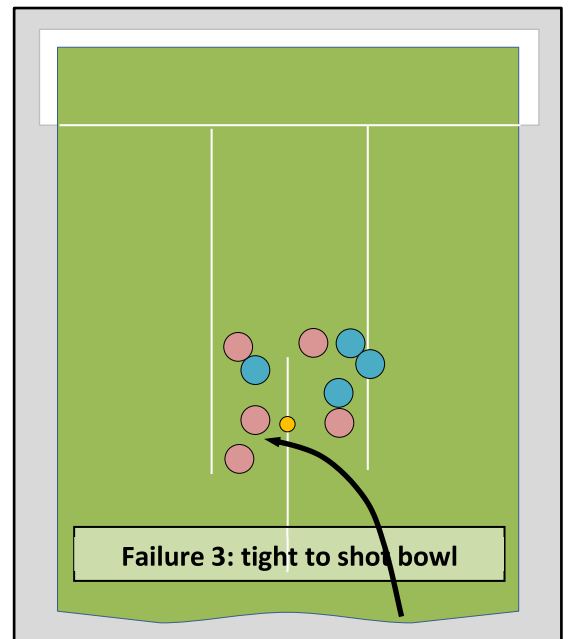


### PERFECT BUT JACK HIGH

If your draw shot finishes between the jack and the second bowl, it will be the shot bowl but your opponent will have an opportunity to push your bowl through and stay in its place for 4 shots.

### FAILURE 3: TIGHT TO THE SHOT BOWL

In playing the draw shot, if you are slightly tight, there is a good chance that your bowl will lodge on the shot bowl and, if you are not holding shot, will at least reduce the count to 1 down. Finishing here, your bowl is locked in and can't be easily moved.



### FAILURE 4: CHIP THE JACK

If you are slightly tight and slightly heavy, there is a chance that you will chip the jack back where you have a 4-to-1 advantage. The best result is that you hold 3 shots and the worst result is that you are 1 down.
